ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Master of Business Administration (MBA) program at the University of Charleston is an innovative program for working individuals who want to advance their careers and broaden their education backgrounds.

The curriculum relies heavily on practical experience to give candidates insight into the intricacies of a constantly changing economic world.

The course is divided into five, 12-week modules. Two formats are available:

- Every other weekend or
- One night per week

The program can be completed in 14 months.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Master of Forensic Accounting (MFA) is the premier graduate degree in accounting. The MFA is designed to accommodate the time constraints of working professionals. Its hybrid structure maximizes the joint benefits of online learning and traditional face-to-face instruction. The program can be completed in fourteen months, with only seven campus visits.

Students benefit not only from the expertise of experienced instructors, but also from shared experiences with a diverse peer group. 



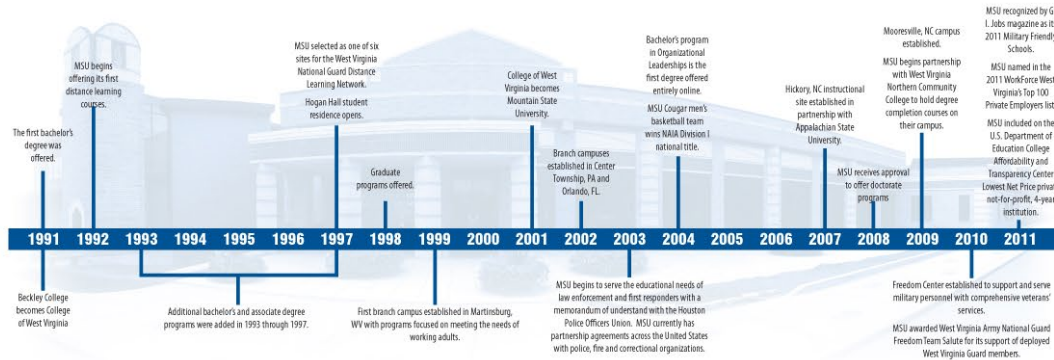

An Historical Snapshot

Nineteen hundred thirty three: Franklin Delano Roosevelt took office as the 32nd president of the United States. Unemployment of 13 to 15 million Americans and failure of nearly half of the country's banks signaled the lowest point in the Great Depression. FDR's New Deal established the first of many Civilian Conservation Corps camps in West Virginia. And, the National Industrial Recovery Act protected the rights of unions and allowed for the rapid organization in the state's southern coalfields. Beckley, West Virginia founded Beckley College.

Serving Those Who Serve

During the past academic year, Mountain State University had 626 military students enroll from all branches of service. MSU's record of supporting active duty servicemembers and their dependents, as well as veterans, is recognized by G.I. Jobs magazine in its naming MSU to its 2011 and 2012 Military Friendly School List—the top 15 percent of colleges, universities, and trade schools that embrace America's veterans as students each year.

Additionally, MSU was honored by the West Virginia Army National Guard for the Freedom Team Salute Award in December 2010. The award is an official program sponsored by the Secretary of the Army and Chief of Staff of the Army that allows soldiers to officially recognize organizations within the community who empower them to be the best that they can be.

Supporting its outreach efforts, MSU operates the Freedom Center, which provides military and veteran students and their dependents with full access to all administrative services in a single location on MSU's Beckley campus.

Serving Students Through Partnerships

Relationships with organizations, such as Sheetz, allow employees the opportunity to complete their bachelor's and master's degrees. Additionally, MSU collaborates with local institutions within its communities and across the United States to provide educational opportunities, such as holding degree completion classes at West Virginia Northern Community College.

"New River has a positive working relationship with Mountain State, which continues to support students at both institutions. We cooperate on many levels, including community programming and student transfer," stated Dr. Ted D. Spring, president of New River Community and Technical College. "Mountain State continues to provide our students with a viable transfer option in programs leading to careers. Over the years, staff at New River have taken professional level courses at Mountain State, and we view the University as a positive influence in supporting professional growth."

Giving Back

Food drives, health initiatives, and participation in community activities such as Sherie's Sweep (litter pick-up) and the Beckley Half Marathon are only a few examples of how Mountain State University acts on its mission.

In 2009, MSU partnered with the City of Mount Hope, Fayette County to open the Fayette County Evidence Processing Center. MSU students used the facility to collect impression evidence and DNA from area crimes scenes. Funded through grants from the United States Department of Justice for two years, the lab processed evidence for the county for over 250 cases.

MSU's Students in Free Enterprise (SIFE) team was awarded first place in the national Campbell's Lets Can Hunger Challenge and advanced to the national SIFE competition for six consecutive years. Other community outreach efforts include fundraising efforts for the YMCA of Southern West Virginia, the United Way of Southern West Virginia, and the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life.

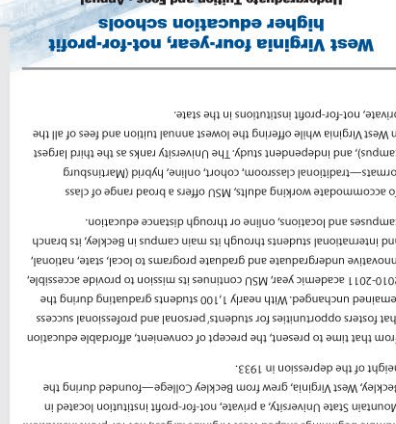
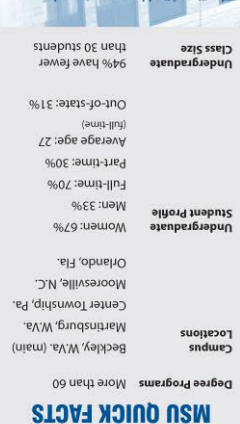

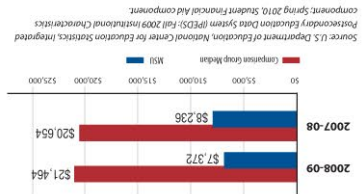

To accommodate working adults, MSU offers a broad range of class formats—traditional classroom, cohort, online, hybrid (Martinsburg campus)—and independent study. The University ranks as the third largest in West Virginia while offering the lowest annual tuition and fees of all the private, not-for-profit institutions in the state.

- ☒ The total, unduplicated count of students enrolled fall 2012, was 4,182 with 2,709 (65%) having a West Virginia address. The average monthly spending (excluding tuition, fees, books and residence hall charges) for students residing West Virginia was \$2,888.26. Estimated annual spending for these students is \$54,825,565.47.
- ☒ Total individuals employed full- or part-time at MSU during fall 2011 semester was 936, with 733 (78%) living in West Virginia. Average reported monthly spending for employees (faculty, administration and staff) was \$2,306,751.54 for a total annual spending of \$27,681,018.52.
- ☒ MSU is committed to utilizing local businesses wherever possible. During the 2010-2011 fiscal year, MSU purchased \$5,907,711 worth of goods and services from 695 West Virginia vendors.
- ☒ Considering both direct and indirect spending, MSU's calculated annual impact on the State of West Virginia is \$141,462,871. Additionally, the Bureau of Economic Analysis estimates that 20 jobs are generated for each \$1 million of output. Based on the calculated annual impact, MSU generates approximately 2,820 jobs in the State of West Virginia.

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Methods of Participation

The Doctor of Executive Leadership is rigorous, accessible, and affordable. It is offered online and requires a five-day campus residency at the beginning of each year of study.

Application

To apply for admission to the program, candidates must complete an application packet that includes the application for admission, official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended, a three- to five-page discussion paper describing the applicant's anticipated contribution to a doctoral leadership cohort, a resume detailing a minimum of five years of professional experience in a leadership role, and letters of academic and professional recommendation. Applicants are required to have a master's or first professional degree from a regionally accredited institution. Once the application is complete, prospective students are interviewed by the program's admissions committee.



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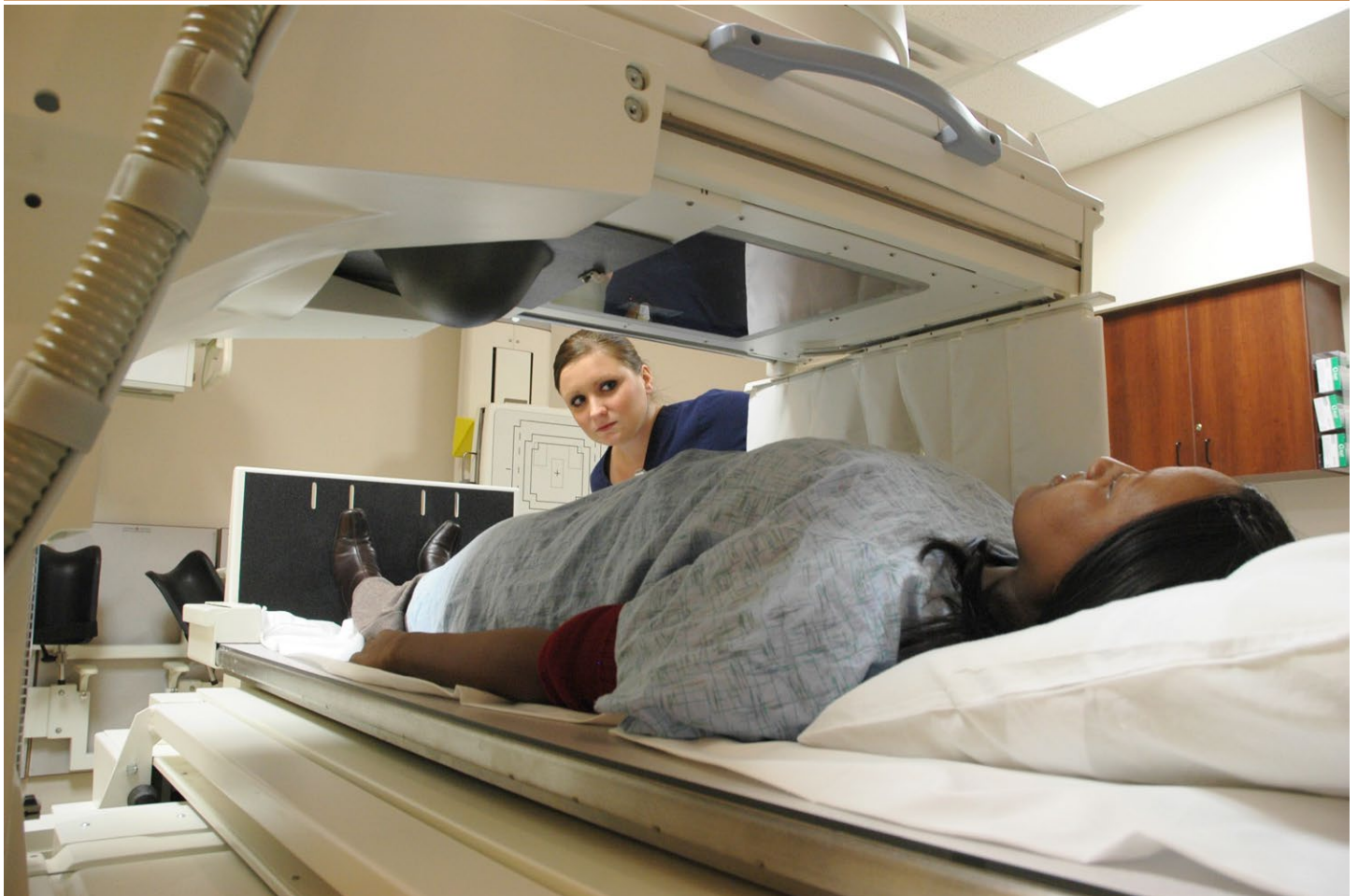
